International Code of Conduct for Private Security Providers

The “*International Code of Conduct for Private Security Providers*” (ICoC) is a multi-stakeholder initiative convened by the Swiss Government.

The Code articulates responsibilities of private security companies under human rights and international humanitarian law to ensure the responsible provision of private security services, particularly when operating in complex environments.



By signing the ICoC, signatory companies publicly commit to operate in accordance with the Code and to work with relevant stakeholder to establish this mechanism and related standards as the industry standard.
